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Notification of the Collection, Processing and Use of Personal Information of Examination Candidates by National Formosa University

Pursuant to the "Personal Information Protection Act" (hereafter "the Act") and in order to ensure the protection of your personal information, privacy and rights, please read in detail the following "Notification of the Collection, Processing and Use of Personal Information of Examination Candidates" formulated by National Formosa University (hereafter "the School") according to Article 8 and 9 of the Act.

- 1. Agency (name): National Formosa University
- 2. Reasons for gathering personal information:

For performing the test service of the School's admission test, the information (communication) and database management, the statistical research and analysis, and the relevant or required works of the student data management after the enrollment.

3. Way of gathering personal information:

The examination candidates' personal information obtained via the personal delivery, the mail delivery, the fax or online registration.

4. Types of personal information gathered:

Include name, ID or ARC or Passport number, birthday, photo, gender, educational information, emergency contact person, address, email address, contact information, transfer account, proof of the low-income or the middle-low income family, health record. The statutory types of personal information (Note) are: C001, C002, C003, C011, C021, C023, C033, C034, C038, C051, C052, C056, C057, C061, C062, C064, C072, C111, C132.

- 5. Handling and use of personal information:
 - (1) Utilizing period:

The utilizing period is the required duration of completing the aforementioned information gathering apart from the expiration date of the personal information for the tests conducted by the ordinance or the central division authority's additional regulation.

- (2) The region within which personal information will be used: Taiwan (including Penghu, Kinmen and Matsu) or places where handling and use has been approved by the examination candidates.
- (3) Users of personal information:

The units of the School and the relevant cooperative units of completing the aforementioned information gathering, including the Ministry of Education or other administrative, academic and research institutions.

- (4) Way of using:
 - a. The required exposure (announcement) based on the public trust of the test service, the academic research and other necessary methods for achieving the

- aforementioned collection objectives due to the School's proceeding of the test service, admitting, registering, approval, enrollment and students management, contacting the examination candidates (or parents and guardians).
- b. The School is allowed to provide the personal or relevant information to the related authority or judiciary by the regulation or the demand of the authority or judiciary by law.
- 6. The untrue, incorrect and incomplete personal information will cause the failure of registering the test, contacting for emergency, and delivering the grades, and that influence the examination candidates' rights of testing, follow-up test service and accepting the test service. The examination candidates should confirm all provided personal information to be true and correct. If there is any false or requiring alteration, please submit the relevant documentary identification to the Admissions Section, Office of Academic Affairs of the School for the application of correction.
- 7. In accordance with the Act, the examination candidates can inquire about the information or request to read it, ask for copies, supplement, correct, ask to cease the gathering, use and handling, and for deletion. The examination candidates can exercise the above rights by submitting a hard copy in writing, by fax and by phone with this request to the School (Please check the Registration Requirements for the contacting information). The request of ceasing the gathering, use and handling and for deletion must not obstruct the School's duty by law.

National Formosa University 2022 Academic Year Fall Semester Enrollment Guide for International Students

1. Eligibility

According to "National Formosa University Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan" (this Regulation), applicants who should meet both following requirements of identity and qualification:

(1) Nationality (Applicant's Identity)

According to International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan, Applicants must meet one of the following requirements in order to apply for admission as an international student in Taiwan:

- 1. Foreign nationals who have never acquired citizenship of the Republic of China (R.O.C.) (note 1) and moreover have never studied with overseas Chinese status in Taiwan (note 2) and have not received the student status from the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students in the enrollment year.
- 2. Foreign nationals who have resided overseas for 6 consecutive years or more (till August 1, 2023)may apply as international students provided:
 - (1) The applicant has never had permanent residence and domicile in the R.O.C. if he has acquired R.O.C. citizenship upon application.
 - (2) The applicant has acquired R.O.C. citizenship prior to application yet has legally divested from the R.O.C. citizenship at least 8 years (till August 1, 2023) before the time of application.
 - (3) The applicant of both the above categories has never attended any academic institution in the R.O.C. as an overseas Chinese and has never attended any overseas college entrance examinations.
 - ** The application submitted by one who has both foreign nationality and R.O.C. nationality, but who has already sent in application of his/her R.O.C. citizenship having been suspended for more than 8 years by making the due declaration to the Ministry of the Interior before February 1, 2011. Everything should be processed according to the original regulations. (i.e. not affected by the regulations of the preceding Paragraph)
- 3. An individual of foreign nationality who are Hong Kong or Macau Permanent Residents without household registration in Taiwan and has lived continuously overseas, in Hong Kong, or in Macau for over 6 years (note 3) at the time of application. (till August 1, 2023).
- 4. An individual that was once residents of Mainland China who is of foreign nationality without household registration in Taiwan and has lived continuously overseas for over 6 years (note 3) at the time of registration. (till August 1, 2023).

[Note 1]	Article 2 of Nationality Act of R.O.C.: Those who meet one of the following regulations should possess nationality of the Republic of China: Biological father or mother has nationality of R.O.C. at the time of birth. If born after the death of biological father or mother, by the time of his/her death, he or she is citizen of R.O.C. Was born in the territories of R.O.C., when biological father and mother were either unidentifiable or stateless. Has been naturalized.
[Note 2]	Overseas Chinese Students should apply to the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Student. According to Article 2 of Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan, "The Overseas Chinese Students mentioned in the paragraph refers to overseas Chinese students who were born overseas and have resided continuously from birth to date, or have resided overseas continuously for the most recent 6 years, and possess permanent or long term residence permit. The recognition of overseas student's status is notarized by the office handling overseas Chinese affairs.
[Note 3]	The term "overseas" means countries or regions other than Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau. The "six years" calculation means starting from the enrolled semester date as in August, 1, 2023 to be the final date, and to push back six years (i.e. from July 31, 2017 to August 1, 2023) The term "continuously" means that an individual may stay in Taiwan for no more than a total of 120 days per calendar year. Should the calculation of continuous years living overseas start in an incomplete calendar year, the stay of each year in Taiwan must be below 120 days in order to be included. Individuals under one of the situations below and with related documents of proof may be excluded, the time resided in Taiwan will not be included in the count of overseas residence: (1) Having studied at training sessions at Overseas Affairs affiliated institutes or professional training courses notarized by the Ministry of Education.
	 (2) Having studied at Ministry of Education approved Chinese Language Centers in colleges or universities for less than 2 years in total. (3) Having been an exchange student for less than 2 years in total. (4) Having had internships at Taiwan sanctioned central industry competent authorities for less than 2 years in total.

Eligibility is based on MOE (Ministry of Education). Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan. If there have been any changes or updates to the regulations, the latest version announced by the MOE prevails. For the latest information about MOE regulations, please contact the MOE.

(2) Education Background

Degree/Diploma: Applicants should meet one of the following criteria and qualified as one of the identities listed may apply for degree-seeking programs.

- i. Graduates from a high school, university, or independent academy, which is recognized by the Ministry of Education, are eligible to apply for admission. (Please refer to the website of "the Database for the Reference List of Foreign Universities")
- ii. Individuals with equivalent degrees stipulated in "<u>Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Level As Qualified for Entering University</u>" by the Ministry of Education are eligible to apply for admission.
- iii. Academic credentials from Mainland China: The "Regulations Governing the Accreditation of Schools in Mainland China" shall apply.

- iv. Academic credentials from Hong Kong or Macao: "<u>Academic Credential Verification and Accreditation Methods adopted in Hong Kong and Macao</u>" shall apply.
- v. Academic credentials referred to the preceding 2 Items shall be subject to the "Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Foreign Academic Credentials for Institutions of Higher Education."
- vi. International students who are dismissed from university/college after admission due to behavior issues, poor academic performance or a conviction under the Criminal Law may thereafter not apply for admission under this regulation.

©Undergraduate admissions

- 1. Foreign students with high school diplomas are eligible for 4-year.
- 2. Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) (or Form 5) students should have equivalent eligibility of a high school diploma to apply for undergraduate programs. Admitted applicants during their study are required to take additional courses for graduation (note).

Note:

Graduates of a school in a foreign country, Hong Kong, or Macau, who have been admitted to an undergraduate program based on their equivalent education level, i.e. second year of senior high school in Taiwan and the school from which they graduated is in the same category and at the same level as that in Taiwan, should take additional 12 graduation credits in accordance with the NFU regulations, in addition to completing the total graduation credits required by their departments. ©Graduate admissions

- 1. Foreign students with Bachelor's degrees are eligible for master programs; and those with master's degrees are eligible for doctoral programs.
- 2. Foreign students who have completed their bachelor's degrees (or above) in Taiwan and wish to apply for higher education are required to present their diplomas and official transcripts and follow the application procedure.

(3) Further Explanation

- i. According to "Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan," Article 4:
 - An international student applying to study at an educational institution in Taiwan in accordance with the provisions of the two previous articles is limited to only applying once [English note: a person may apply to more than one educational institution, but if one of these applications is successful and they then study in Taiwan, they cannot subsequently apply to study at another educational institution for a course at that level]. After completing the course of study at the educational institution to which they applied, unless the student is applying for admission to a program for a master's degree or a higher degree, which may be handled by each university in accordance with its regulations, if the students wants to continue studying in Taiwan, their application shall be handled in the same manner as the admission procedures for domestic students.
- ii. Violation of any of the above-mentioned eligibilities of status and academic qualifications will result in immediate cancellation of the applicant's admission, or deprivation of the applicant's recognized status as National Formosa University registered student, or revocation of applicant's National Formosa University

diploma. No certificates will be awarded.

iii. International students who are dismissed from university/college after admission due to behavior issues, poor academic performance or a conviction under the Criminal Law may thereafter not apply for admission under this regulation.

(4) Non-native Speaker Language Ability Requirements

Students who apply for a program that is taught in Chinese should be proficient in Chinese listening, speaking, reading, and writing; students who apply for a program that is taught in English should be proficient in English listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Applicants need to submit proof of language proficiency with their application.

Suggested certificates of language proficiency are as follows

For programs taught in Chinese:
 Students must have adequate listening, speaking, reading, and writing Chinese language skills. Documents or proofs of Chinese proficiency*

Note1: exemption: Applicants who are native speakers of the Chinese language or graduated from a school where Chinese is the language of instruction or the major in college used to be Chinese.

Note2: Proofs of Chinese proficiency means any related documents which issued by institutes for Chinese proficiency test such as Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language (TOCFL) from Taiwan, Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) from Mainland China, Subject Test in Chinese with Listening (SAT) from United States, or certificates from Chinese courses of universities/colleges in Taiwan and so on.

Note3: For those applying for degree programs taught in Chinese, a photocopy of a TOCFL transcript or certificate for Level 2 or above. (Registration System: https://reg.sc-top.org.tw/register.php)

- If an international student accepts a Chinese conditional admission offer, he or she will have to obtain a Chinese proficiency certificate at the designated level or above in order to be accepted for enrollment. and will be cancelled if he or she fails to provide such documents.

ii. For programs taught in English:

Non-native English speakers must have adequate listening, speaking, reading, and writing English language skills. Proofs of Test of Proficiency- English*

Note1: exemption: Applicants who are native speakers of the English language or graduated from a school where English is the language of instruction.

- 5. Application Fees and Methods of Payment

 - i. The application fee is non-refundable under any circumstances, including cases of incomplete applications, cancelled applications, ineligible applications, late applications, overpayment, double payment, mistaken payment and etc.
 - ii. Those who do not pay the application fees will not have their applications processed.
- (2) Methods of Payment:

6. Required Documents

- **Method of examination is through document review, After finishing the forms online and application materials must be submitted between March 27, 2023 and May 15, 2023, as indicated by postal date stamp. Late applications will not be processed.**
- **◎** If the applicants <u>would like to apply for more than one department (program), in which case separate all documents.</u>
- All required materials for application should be presented in either Chinese or English, and should applicants fail in meeting the deadline or haven't sent in the required documents, their applications won't be accepted. NFU will review the applications, and if applicants do not meet the requirements, or fail to submit all required documents, NFU will reject them.
- (1) A list of submitted documents (Applicants are to make a for each included application material on the list (see Attachment 1))
- (2) Application form (please fill out online and print out the paper copy. Please provide a 2-inch photo. (see Attachment 2))
- (3) Photocopy of Application Fee Receipt
- (4) Verification of nationality (e.g. a photocopy of your passport)
- (5) Original copy of applicant's certified diploma which is notarized by R.O.C. (Taiwan) Embassy, Representative Office, Economic and Cultural Office or other organizations authorize by Ministry of Foreign Affairs. or Official academic records from applicants' secondary schools or colleges/universities in sealed envelopes and shall be sent to Office of International Affairs. (*If the diploma certificate and transcripts are not in Chinese or English, applicants should submit an English or Chinese translation stamped and signed by the issuing institution or a notary office.)
 - Applicants for four-year bachelor's programs: Please provide a high school diploma
 - Applicants for Master programs: Please provide a bachelor degree's diploma

- Applicants for the Ph.D. programs: Please provide a master degree's diploma
- Graduating applicants need not submit graduation certificate at the time of application (other than proof of their student status), but it must be submitted at the time of registration; otherwise, the admission qualification will be canceled.

Note:

- i. Official academic records from applicants' secondary schools or colleges/universities, NFU has the right to ask for certified documents from R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas offices if needed.
- ii. Bachelor program: high school transcripts of every semester Master program: undergraduate transcripts of every semester Ph.D. Program: graduate transcripts of every semester
- iii. After receiving the admission, diploma, copy of transcript and financial support statement which are notarized by R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas offices are required and should be handed to process the registration.
- iv. Acceptance letters or admissions notices do not guarantee visa issuance. Visas are approved by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Taiwan overseas representative office. While applying for visas, some of the R.O.C. representative offices may ask for a Chinese proficiency certificate (for programs taught in Chinese) or English proficiency certificate (for programs taught in English). For more information about visas, please visit an R.O.C. representative office.
- (6) Certification for language proficiency (such as TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS, TOCFL, HSK, etc.)
 - *Students from Vietnam and Indonesia applying for a visa to study in Taiwan will also need to provide a foreign language proficiency certificate. For more information, Vietnamese applicants please refer to : https://www.roc-taiwan.org/vn/post/4121.html. / Indonesia applicant please refer to : https://www.roc-taiwan.org/id/post/3300.html.
- (7) Copy of bank letter certifying sufficient fund to support studies in Taiwan: a financial statement issued by a financial institution within the past three months (the equivalent of at least NT\$150,000 or US\$5,000 annually) or proof of full scholarship provided by a government agency, university, college, or private organization.
 - *The financial support statement shall be notarized by R.O.C. (Taiwan) Embassy or be sent directly by applicants' banks in sealed envelopes to Office of International Affairs. Financial support statements from banks of Taiwan are not required to be notarized.
- (8) Two letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes (For graduate program applicants only)
- (9) A Chinese or English study plan (For graduate program applicants only) (refer to Attachment 3)
- (10) Autobiography within 1000 words (refer to Attachment 4)
- (11) Declaration of Attendance at NFU University (see Attachment 5)
- (12) Letter of authority (see Attachment 6)
- (13) Deposition related to application documents (see Attachment 7)
- (14)Documents Required by Applied Departments (Please check the application instructions for program specific requirements and submit them.)

- (15)Individuals holding foreign nationality and holding or once had R.O.C. nationality shall submit the certificate to prove he/she have stayed abroad continually (more than 6 years while applying).
- (16) Individuals holding a foreign nationality and once had R.O.C. nationality but have never had household registration in Taiwan shall submit certificate issued by Ministry of Interior to prove his/her stay for more than 8 years.

7. Important Reminders

- (1) Applicants should make sure if they are qualified by checking all criteria intended by departments. In addition, If you are from designated countries, such as Algeria, Bangladesh, Cameroon, Ghana, Nigeria, Pakistan, etc., please make sure you will have guarantor in Taiwan to ensure your visa legitimacy before you submit the application. For more information, please refer to Procedures for Nationals of the Designated Countries Applying for Visitor Visas to the Republic of China (R.O.C.) (Link: https://www.boca.gov.tw/cp-159-249-4162c-2.html)
- (2) The diploma and transcript submitted for application review shall first be authenticated in accordance with the rules promulgated by the R.O.C. Ministry of Education, except for diplomas and transcripts issued by Overseas Taiwanese or Overseas Chinese schools.
- (3) Foreign students who have been forced to drop out at any institution in Taiwan due to their behavior problems, failed academic performances and criminal records are not allowed to apply for admission. Should any of the above violation cases be verified, the applicant's student status will be revoked immediately.
- (4) Foreign students who have the household registration, naturalization or restoration to R.O.C. nationality during your study have to lose your foreign students status and accept the discontinuation of your study by the University.
- (5) According to regulation issued by Taiwan Ministry of Education, applicants should present NFU a valid medical insurance of 6 months started from the date of entering Taiwan.
- (6) Applicants should submit a health certificate (including an HIV Antibody Test) issued within 3 months by one of the local hospitals designated by the Centers for Disease Control of Ministry of Health and Welfare of the R.O.C. or a foreign hospital when applying for a visa.

- (8) A limited number of tuition waivers are awarded to foreign students each year. Students could apply for the tuition waiver by checking appropriate box in the application form.

11. Scholarships

13. Registration

Proof of insurance must be authenticated by an overseas representative office of the Republic of China (Taiwan). If you hold a valid National Health Insurance (NHI) card in Taiwan, you may provide the original and one photocopy instead of purchasing insurance. If you are unable to present proof of insurance when you register, the University will purchase medical insurance on your behalf until you receive National Health Insurance.

(2) Retaining Admission:

If you are prevented from enrolling for reasons such as illness, pregnancy, childbirth, taking care of a child under 3 years old, or other exceptional circumstances, you may submit relevant documents and apply to retain your admission status for up to one year. Under special circumstances, you may be able to apply to retain admission status for one additional year afterwards. If you would like to retain your admission status, please submit a written application along with your academic documents to the Office of Academic Affairs before the first day of class specified in the academic calendar; no fee is required.

- (3) For details on leaves of absence, limits on the duration of study, graduation requirements, required credits and credit waivers, please check out the <u>website of the</u> Office of Academic Affairs.
