Politeknik Negeri Malang (POLINEMA) is a vocational higher education institution located in Malang, Indonesia. One of the long-standing departments is the Accounting Department, which was established in 1986. The establishment of the department received assistance from The Australian Project. Since November 2004 Universitas Brawijaya Polytechnic has obtained an independent status to become State Polytechnic of Malang. In 2022, several study programs in Polinema have obtained an international accreditation from ASIC, one of them is Master of Applied Study Program in Accounting Information Systems (Magister Terapan Sistem Informasi Akuntansi-MTSIA).

Participants for both competitions are either undergraduate or graduate students from any departments. Students' study backgrounds are **NOT limited** by accounting, business, management, or economy. All students from any departments are highly encouraged to join the competitions.



Participants must take part in the competition in groups with a maximum of 5 people in the business simulation competition. A student can represent only one group and one university/institution at a time.



Participants must take part in the competition in groups with a maximum of 3 people in the poster competition.



Participants for both competitions must register online through the TREASURE website. After registering, participants are expected to join the WhatsApp group via the link provided by the committee at the end of the registration stage.
